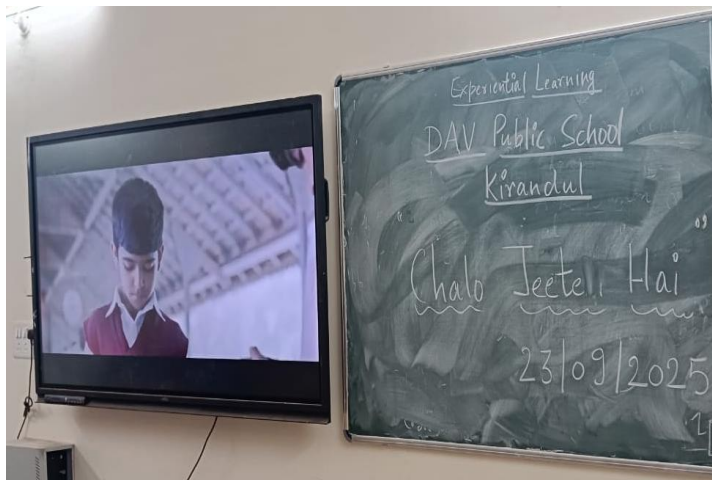
Total Audience: 830 students, along with teachers and some parents
